Procedure

After presenting the submissions as impulse presentations, we would like to talk about these topics in detail in a moderated discussion.

Active phases are also planned, in which, for example something can be tried out or presented. We are open to your suggestions for this – please feel free to submit them. ¹

Publication

Jointly developed results of the workshop will be published in the conference proceedings. For the documentation of these results we will form a working group after the conference, in which you are welcome to participate.

Accepted articles are automatically part of the conference proceedings.

Submission

On the workshop website *education.cerc-conf.eu* you will find a link to a submission PDF, which you should fill out and send to the email address below.

In this PDF, please describe your intention in the *Abstract* field on max. 1 page in English.

In the *further explanations* field, you can optionally enter details of your intention in English or German that are useful for clarification.

Example: In the abstract you describe a new learning method that you use in practice. In the explanations you describe an experiment that you would like to conduct with the participants.
